## SECTION I

# Eligibility for Admission

### A Eligibility for B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme

- ▶ Candidates seeking admission to **Physical Science Group** must have passed Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics (PCM). Candidates seeking admission to **Biological Science Group (CBZ)** must have passed Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (PCB).
- ▶ Candidates must have passed +2 / Hr. Sec. / Sr. Sec. or any equivalent examination recognised by University / Board with at least **50% marks**.
- ▶ Candidates who have passed +2 or any equivalent examination in **2024, 2025** or appearing / appeared in **2026** only.

### B Eligibility for B.A. B.Ed. Course

Candidates must have passed +2 / Hr. Sec. / Sr. Sec. or any equivalent examination recognised by University / Board with at least **50% marks**.

Candidates who have passed +2 or any equivalent examination in **2024, 2025** or appearing / appeared in **2026** only.

**Note:** The relaxation as per State Govt. of Haryana / affiliating University norms will be applicable to relevant categories.

### C SC Category Relaxation — 5% Marks

Reduction / Relaxation of **5% marks** in the eligibility conditions shall be granted to the Scheduled Caste

#### Calculation Example:

Out of 100 marks to reduce =  $5/100 \times 100 = 5$  | Out of 50 marks to reduce =  $5/100 \times 50 = 2.50$

Hence, where general category requires **50%**, total required marks for SC candidate = **50 – 2.50 = 47.50**.

# Instructions – Section II

Admission Schedule for 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP)

The admission schedule for ITEP Programme will be available on institute website i.e. [www.siaсте.ac.in](http://www.siaсте.ac.in) and when the result of NCET is declared by the NTA.

- 1 The admission to 4-Year ITEP Programmes shall be made on the basis of the merit prepared as per the score in the **National Common Entrance Test (NCET-2026)** conducted by the NTA.
- 2 Candidates must fill in their choices of Programmes carefully.
- 3 For this purpose, the candidate must check the breakup / availability of seats (Category-Wise) as mentioned in the Brochure.
- 4 The counseling will be held in physical mode in **SIASTE Jhajjar, Haryana** no request for online mode will be considered.
- 5 Candidates are required to fill offline separate Admission Form for B.A. B.Ed. and B.Sc. B.Ed. 4-Year Programs offered by SIASTE Jhajjar.
- 6 Documents in support of reservation category issued up to the date of counseling shall be acceptable.
- 7 Fee is to be submitted online through **Debit Card / Net Banking only**.
- 8 The candidate must submit fee receipt to the office of the Institute in person.
- 9 **The merit list for each program will be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in the Entrance Test** and seats will be allotted accordingly during the physical / online counseling as per schedule.
- 10 The candidate shall be personally responsible in case he/she is not eligible to apply as per the given eligibility criteria.
- 11 The Candidates shall report to SIASTE Jhajjar for Physical Counseling.

 **Counseling Reporting:** Exact date and time of counselling will be made available on institute website i.e. [www.siaсте.ac.in](http://www.siaсте.ac.in). No individual communication will be made.

- 12 The candidates are advised to visit SIASTE's website regularly for updates.
- 13 Benefit of reservation will be given to all the reserved categories up to **3rd counseling**. If reserved seats remain vacant and no eligible candidates are available, these seats may be thrown open to Haryana General Category, and then to All India Open Category.

# Instructions – Section III

## DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF COUNSELING

- ✓ Incomplete / Incorrect Admission Form shall be summarily rejected.
- ✓ The candidates must bring all original documents and Self Attested Copies (2 sets) along with Admission form, at the time of Physical Counseling.
- ✓ Matriculation Certificate (as proof of age)
- ✓ Senior Secondary Examination Pass Certificate / Detailed Marks Card (DMC)
- ✓ Character Certificate from the School last attended
- ✓ Certificate of Reserved Category and other related certificates, if applicable, as mentioned in the Brochure.
- ✓ **Latest Income Certificate** issued by the competent authority of the Haryana Govt.
- ✓ Haryana resident certificate, if applicable.
- ✓ Copy of **Parivar Pehchan Patra (PPP) (Only for Haryana candidate)**
- ✓ Undertaking regarding Gap Year, if applicable.

In case, original DMC of the qualifying examination is not available, the applicant may submit the downloaded result from the internet, duly certified by the Head of the concerned School. However, the original DMC must be submitted within **10 days after admission / before the registration**, whichever comes earlier.

## EWS CATEGORY NOTES

- ① A candidate who has applied under **EWS-(AI) category** and is a bonafide resident of Haryana / passed the qualifying Exam from Haryana, may be considered against the seats reserved for the Economically Weaker Section of Haryana, if possesses Haryana EWS Certificate.
- ② A candidate who has applied under **Haryana EWS category** and does not possess Haryana EWS certificate, may be considered for EWS seats under All India category, if possesses EWS-(AI) Certificate as per Central Govt. Policy.
- ③ A candidate possessing **EWS certificate from Haryana** shall be eligible for consideration for admission to EWS-AI category seats.

# Instructions – Section IV

How to Apply for Admission to Various Programs

## HOW TO APPLY

- ▶ The candidates are advised to read the Brochure of **(NTA NCET-2026)** carefully before filling the online Application Form.
- ▶ A Candidate may apply for admission to programs as he/she wants.
- ▶ The candidates are required to fill up the percentage of marks secured in each examination using the conversion formula given by the board, wherever applicable.
- ▶ The candidates claiming the benefit of reservation shall submit the latest and valid required certificate issued by the competent authority. Please refer to Appendices for instructions and formats of various certificates.
- ▶ For claiming any benefit under Haryana State Govt. initiatives, the candidate should fill up the correct **Parivar Pahchan Patra (PPP ID)** issued by the Govt. of Haryana, if any. The benefit shall be subject to validation of PPP ID as per due procedure.
- ▶ Other state candidate may not require PPP ID.
- ▶ Candidate of Haryana claiming reservation under BC-A, BC-B categories must bring relevant categories mentioning BC-A , BC-B. The OBC certificate of Haryana without mention of category shall not be considered.

# Criteria for Preparing Merit List & Seat Matrix

## MERIT LIST CRITERIA

- ▶ The merit list for 4-Year ITEP Programs shall be made on the basis of the score in the **National Common Entrance Test (NCET-2026)** conducted by the NTA.
- ▶ The candidate **senior in age** will be given preference, if two or more candidates secure identical marks in NCET.

# Admission Procedure

For selection of candidates for B.A. B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. programs

- 1 Mere possession of the prescribed academic qualifications does not entitle a candidate for admission. Candidates would be required to fulfill all the conditions as spelt out in the Brochure.
- 2 Merit list of the eligible candidates as per criteria given in the Brochure shall be displayed on the SIASTE, Jhajjar notice board on the dates given in the Brochure.
- 3 If two or more candidates secure identical marks in the merit, the candidate **senior in age** will be given preference.
- 4 Counselling for admission to the programs will be held in **physical mode / Online** as per Counselling Schedule given in the Admission Brochure. Separate communication if needed shall be sent in this regard.
- 5 The original certificates / testimonials and copies of all the examinations passed by the candidate from 10th & 12th standard, other documents and latest Character Certificate shall be produced at the time of counseling. The Admission Committee will check the eligibility of the candidate. This Committee shall have the power to reject any certificate not considered valid. In case, the candidate is not found eligible, his/her candidature will be cancelled.
- 6 All eligible candidates shall be required to pay the fee online through **Debit Card / Net banking only** on the dates mentioned in the admission schedule failing which his/her candidature shall be cancelled.
- 7 Seats, remaining vacant after every round of counselling, shall be displayed on the website of Institute / Notice Board of the Institute.
- 8 Those candidates, who do not get admission in first round of counselling, shall be eligible for admission in subsequent rounds, if seats are available.
- 9 Seats, remaining vacant in first round of counselling, will be filled up in the subsequent rounds of counselling.
- 10 Counselling will be closed as soon as all the seats in each category are filled.
- 11 **The decision of the Admission Committee / Director in all matters relating to the admissions shall be final.**

# Distribution & Reservation of Seats

In the event of quota reserved for Physically Handicapped remaining unutilized, it may be offered to the **Ex-Servicemen and their wards (1%)** and the **dependents of Freedom Fighters (1%)**.

Further, 3% reservation is also provided to Ex-servicemen / Freedom Fighters and their dependents — 1% of General Category, 1% out of SC and 1% from BC category.

Fifty percent of the twenty percent seats reserved for Scheduled Castes shall be set aside for candidates belonging to **Deprived Scheduled Castes**. Where such a seat is not filled due to non-availability of DSC candidates, the same shall be made available to SC candidates.

The reservation of seats is as per the Reservation Policy of Haryana Govt. and is subject to change/amendment made by the State Govt. from time to time.

- ▶ Candidates belonging to SC/DSC/ST are required to submit a certificate from the competent authority. The list of Scheduled Castes notified by the Haryana Government.
- ▶ The SEWA Department, Govt. of Haryana under Clause-VI has specified the criteria for exclusion of persons within the Backward Classes as Creamy Layer vide notification No. 40/13/2024-ISW dated 16.07.2024.
- ▶ Candidates belonging to Backward Classes are required to submit a certificate from the competent authority as per Circular nos. 1170-SW(1)-95 dated 07.06.1995 & No.213-SW(1)-2010 dated 31.08.2010 and subsequent notifications.
- ▶ The children or grand children (Maternal & Paternal) of Freedom Fighters are required to submit a certificate from the competent authority as per Haryana Govt. norms.
- ▶ Only those candidates who have permanent disability of **not less than 40%** will be considered for admission as Physically Handicapped. Disability Certificate shall be subject to verification by a Medical Board constituted by the University. The decision of Medical Board shall be final.
- ▶ A candidate who applies for a reserved category will be considered first in general category on the basis of merit. In case not selected in general category, he/she will be considered for reserved category.
- ▶ SC/BC candidates selected in open competition on the basis of their own merit will not be counted against the reserved quota — they will be treated as open competition candidates.
- ▶ If a candidate belongs to more than one reserved category, he/she shall give preference at the time of filling up the admission form. Preference once given shall not be changed.
- ▶ If any seat remains vacant in sub-categories of BC (A) and BC (B), the same will be filled up through candidates belonging to the other sub-category, and vice versa.
- ▶ Benefit of reservation will be given to all the reserved categories up to **3rd counselling** according to the reservation policy given in the Admission Brochure.

EWS CRITERIA — HARYANA STATE

Admission Criteria for EWSs derived from the Government of Haryana, Notification No. 22/12/2019-1GS-III dated 25.02.2019.

**Income & Assets Certificate Issuing Authority**

The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority for EWS Income and Asset Certificate shall be **Tehsildar of the area** where the applicant normally resides.

**Criteria of Income & Assets (Haryana)**

Persons who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservation for Scheduled Caste, Backward Classes (Block-A) and Backward Classes (Block-B) and whose family has gross annual income below **Rs. 6.00 lakh** (Rupees six lakh only) are to be identified as EWSs for benefit of reservation.

Also, persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS:

- ▶ 5 acres of agricultural land and above
- ▶ Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above
- ▶ Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities

- ▶ Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than notified municipalities
- ▶ Total immovable assets owned are valued at Rs. One Crore or more

The property held by a "Family" in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status. The term "Family" for this purpose will include the person who applies for benefit of reservation, his/her parents, spouse as well as children and siblings below the age of 18 years.

#### EWS CRITERIA — ALL INDIA CATEGORY SEATS

The reservation @ **10%** to Economically Weaker Sections in All India Category seats (i.e. 15% of sanctioned intake) under Central Govt. Policy would be in addition to the existing reservation. Admission Criteria for EWSs derived from the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions Department of Personnel & Training, Government of India Notification No. 36039/1/2019-Estt (Res) dated 31.01.2019.

#### Criteria of Income & Assets (Central Govt.)

Persons who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs and whose family has gross annual income below **Rs. 8.00 lakh** (Rupees eight lakh only) are to be identified as EWSs for benefit of reservation.

- ▶ 5 acres of agricultural land and above
- ▶ Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above
- ▶ Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities
- ▶ Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than notified municipalities

#### Income and Asset Certificate Issuing Authority (Central)

The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority. The Income and Asset Certificate issued by any one of the following authorities in the prescribed format shall only be accepted:

- ▶ District Magistrate / Additional District Magistrate / Collector / Deputy Commissioner / Additional Deputy Commissioner / 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate / Sub-Divisional Magistrate / Taluka Magistrate / Executive Magistrate / Extra Assistant Commissioner
- ▶ Chief Presidency Magistrate / Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate / Presidency Magistrate
- ▶ Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar
- ▶ Sub-Divisional Officer or the area where the candidate and/or his family normally resides

# Rules & Regulations

*(Applicable to all candidates seeking admission)*

1. Reservation under any category shall be applicable only to candidates belonging to Haryana domicile as per Government rules. Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from any recognized school/college situated in Haryana may not be required to produce a separate domicile/residence certificate, subject to the latest Government instructions.
2. Anything not mentioned in the Brochure shall be decided as per rules applicable to the institute. The latest rules, regulations, guidelines, and instructions issued by the Government of Haryana, affiliating university, NCTE, and other competent authorities from time to time shall be applicable and binding on all candidates.
3. In case of any dispute regarding admission, eligibility, merit, reservation, fee, documents, or interpretation of rules, the Admission Committee of the institute shall examine and decide the matter as per applicable rules. In case the issue still persists, the matter shall be referred to the Director, SIASTE, whose decision shall be final and binding on all concerned.
4. Fee refund/adjustment shall be governed strictly as per the latest instructions and norms issued by the Government of Haryana, affiliating university, and other competent authorities from time to time.
5. Mere submission of the application form or participation in the counselling/admission process shall not confer any right to admission unless the candidate fulfills all prescribed eligibility conditions.
