Evaluation for Internal Assessment

Criteria for the award of internal assessment of 20 % marks in theory papers may be

As per the distributions given below:-

1. One class test - 10% Marks
 2. One presentation/assignment- 5 % Marks
 3. Attendance 5%

Note: - if a candidate is awarded internal assessment of more than 75%, the Concerned teacher will give specific justification for the same which shall be considered by a committee to be submitted by the concerned principal of the college.
